Welcome to Kidz Corner! We encourage you to use these resources to involve your children with worship today.

Here are some things that you can do with children of all ages:

- Our Verse for today is 1 Samuel 3:9
“He told Samuel, “Go and lie down. If He calls you, say, ‘Speak, Lord, for Your servant is listening.’” So Samuel went and lay down in his place.”
- Have your child watch today’s Bible story at this [LINK](#).
- The memory part of today’s verse is “Speak, Lord, for Your servant is listening.” Help your child memorize these words and ask them how they can listen to God this week.
- Ask your children for prayer requests
- During the week, you can look to the Weekly Resources being provided. Each day has an idea of how to share that day’s scripture with your children.



Other ways you can keep your child engaged with scripture are to:

- Leave a post it note on the bathroom mirror, or other personal item with a note of encouragement/scripture on it
- Read a Bible story at bedtime- get creative pull out a puppet, flannel graph, videos, use different voices for different characters in the story, etc...
- Read the Bible together as a family- make sure to pick out a children friendly version that has pictures
- Take time to talk to them about their day, and share how you saw God in your day

While being in God’s word is the primary way of deepening our relationship with God so we can hear His voice, we should also be spending time in prayer, taking time to worship and thank and praise Him for all of His blessings to us. With all the busyness and uncertainty that is going on in the world right now we need to be reassuring one another that God is with us. He will never leave us. He has been faithful in the past. He is faithful today. He will be faithful tomorrow. We need to be still, and hear his voice!
