- The Bible verse that you can help your child learn is, ***"Love your neighbor as yourself."*** Galatians 5:15

- Share pictures of your family in worship on Trinity's Facebook page, be sure your child sees pictures that their friends have posted.

Other ways you can keep your child engaged with scripture are to:

- Continue to ask your children for their prayer requests. Life right now is ever changing, and prayer is one way that you can reassure your child that they are loved and cared for each and every day regardless of the situation of the day. They will learn to look to God and see His hand in their life.
- Create a family collage of pictures cut from magazines, newspapers, etc. that illustrate the Golden Rule in some way. Talk about how good it feels when you are treated kindly by others. Discuss all the blessings that God has given out of His love for you.
- Make a list of ways that you can treat each other more kindly and how you can reach out to others and share the love God so freely gave us in Jesus.
- Using sidewalk chalk write an encouraging message on your driveway to your neighbors. Share God's love as you encourage your neighbor.

Did you know the term Golden Rule is actually not in the Bible? Jesus does tell us to "Treat others the way you want to be treated," and "Love your neighbor as yourself." These messages are a standard of behavior, and a message of God's love for us. What an amazing gift He has given us. As Holy Week approaches think of ways to share His love and shine His light!
