Listen and sing along to [Jesus is Alive!](#)

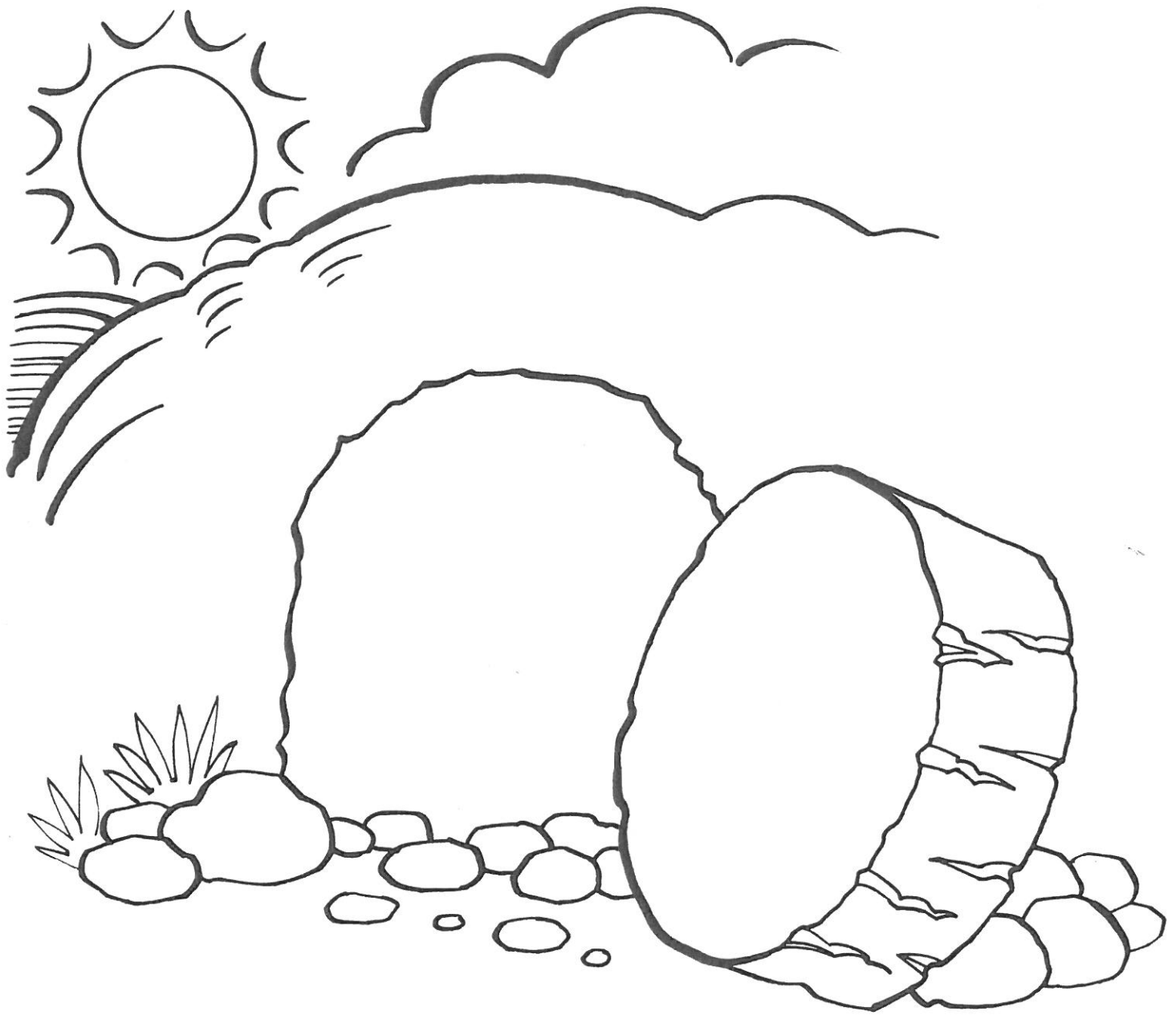

Color and cut out the bookmarks to use in your Bible or favorite books!

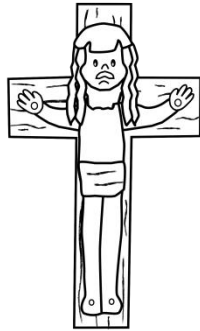


The Easter story

Jesus rode into Nazareth on a donkey. People spread their coats and palm branches on the ground.



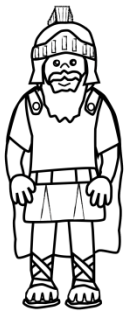
Jesus was nailed to the cross.



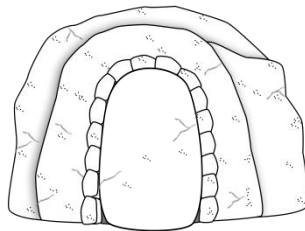
After 3 days, Jesus rose from the dead!

The soldiers arrested Jesus when Judas Iscariot betrayed him for 30 pieces of silver.



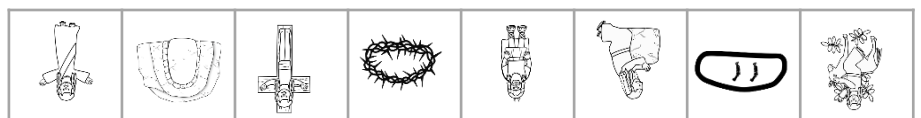
Jesus died. He was placed in a tomb with a large stone rolled in front of it.
