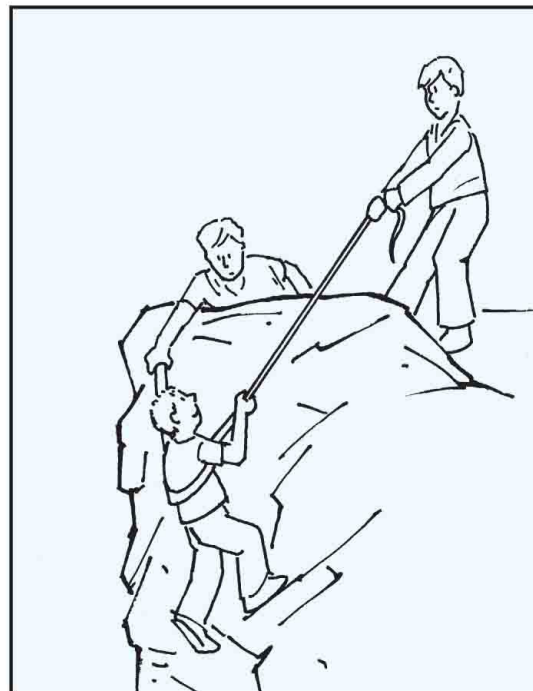

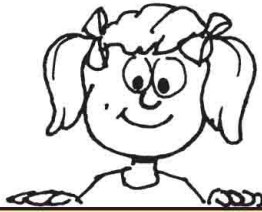
Match the puzzle pieces and write the letters.
