1. What is the problem with the Pharisees and scribes in the opening scene of Mark 7?

4. How does the Psalmist ask to be judged?

The Answers

JANUARY 1

1. The Son of God
2. "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."
3. "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."
4. The path of righteousness which leads to life; the path of wickedness which leads to death.

JANUARY 2

1. He forgives his sins and enables him to walk.
2. "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I came not to call the righteous, but sinners."
3. Man.
4. Lest he become angry and you be destroyed.

JANUARY 3

1. "You are the Son of God."
2. Preach and have authority to drive out demons.
