 ⚡⚡⚡: DEUTERONOMIUM = "SECOND LAW"

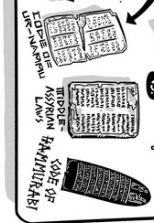

17-20 CIVIL LAWS & SOCIAL JUSTICE
 FINANCIAL, FAMILY & BUSINESS PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL, CRIMINAL & PUNISHMENT

TIPS FOR READING THESE LAWS:

- 1) THE LAWS ARE THE HEARTS OF THE COVENANT GIVEN TO ANOTHER PEOPLE.
- 2) DON'T CHARGE THEM WITH MODERN LAWS, BUT WITH THE LAWS OF ISRAEL'S NEIGHBOURS.
- 3) WORKEN THE CODE THROUGH UNDERSTANDING THE LAW.
