3. What instructions did John give to the multitudes?

4. What instructions did John give to the soldiers?

Discussion: Jesus is by his very nature God's son. How is this different from us?

Mar. 21 LUKE 4-5, PSALM 80

1. What did Jesus announce as the purpose of his ministry?

2. What was the significance of the widow to whom Elijah was sent and the leper cleansed in the days of Elisha? (24-27)

3. What did Peter, Andrew, James and John leave to follow Jesus?

4. What did Jesus teach regarding the garment and the wineskins?

Discussion: Reflect on Peters reluctance and then obedience. How does this relate to our response to the call of Jesus?

LUKE 6-7, PSALM 81

1. What three things did Jesus command the man with the withered hand to do?

2. How long did Jesus spend in prayer before choosing the twelve apostles?

3. How did Jesus commend John the Baptist?

4. What did Jesus say to the woman who anointed His feet?

Discussion: Why is Jesus' forgiving of sins so important? Hint: Who has the authority to forgive sins?

LUKE 8-9, PSALM 82

1. Describe the demoniac before his encounter with Jesus.

2. Describe him after his encounter with Jesus.

3. What did Jesus tell the ex-demoniac to do?

4. What did James and John want to do to the Samaritans who did not receive Jesus?

Discussion: Why is Jesus able to cast out demons? What does this show about who he is?

Mar. 24

LUKE 10-11, PSALM 83

1. Why did Jesus send the seventy out by two's?

2. What question prompted the parable of the Good Samaritan?

3. For what two things did Jesus pronounce woes upon the Pharisees?

4. For what two things did Jesus pronounce woes upon the lawyers?

Discussion: Reflect on the desire for glory and praise. How does this affect how you spend your time, treasures, and talents? How can you work against this addiction?

Mar. 25

LUKE 12-13, PSALM 84


1. What did Jesus say was the leaven of the Pharisees?

2. What did God say to the rich man?

3. What is required of one to whom much is given?

4. How did Jesus show that the ruler of the synagogue who criticized him was a hypocrite?
