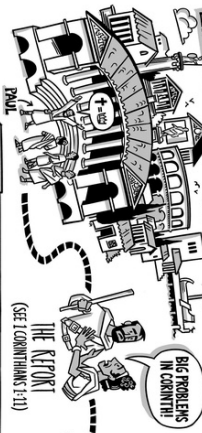

THIS ISN'T REALLY ABOUT MONEY; THEY HAVEN'T BEEN TRANSFORMED BY THE CROSS & A STUDY OF CHRISTOSITY

FOR YOU KNOW THE GENERAL STATE OF OUR LORD JESUS THE MESSAGE THAT EVEN THOUGH HE WAS KING FOR YOUR SAKE HE DECEASED KING SO THAT THROUGH HIS DEATH, YOU MIGHT BECOME KING (9:1)
