Discussion Question: Discuss the covenant between God and David, and David's victories over his enemies.

July 7

2. What is the consequence of David's sin?

3. Where does David set up an altar in response to the plague in 1 Chronicles 21?

4. Who are the Levites appointed by David for the service of the temple in 1 Chronicles 24?

Discussion Question: Discuss David's sin of numbering the people, its consequences, and the establishment of religious service in the temple.

1. What roles are assigned to the Levites in 1 Chronicles 26?

2. Who is chosen to succeed David as king in 1 Chronicles 26?

3. What are David's final words to Solomon in 1 Chronicles 28?

4. What does David pray for in 1 Chronicles 29?

Discussion Question: Discuss the preparation for the transition of kingship from David to Solomon and David's advice to his son.

JULY 2

1. He renews the covenant and purges the nation of idolatry.
2. Zedekiah.
3. It is captured and destroyed by Babylon.
4. Evil-Merodach, king of Babylon

JULY 3

1. Adam, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
2. The descendants of David.
3. God granted his request for blessing and expansion of his territory.
4. The sons of Reuben, Gad, and the half-tribe of Manasseh.

JULY 4

1. They were designated for religious duties, particularly as priests.
2. High priests, from Eleazar through to Jehozadak.
3. The tribe of Benjamin.
4. Saul died in battle against the Philistines.

JULY 5

1. David.
2. They are valiant men of the tribes of Israel who joined David's forces.
3. Uzzah reached out to steady the Ark of the Covenant.
4. Levites.

JULY 7

1. He orders a census of Israel, which was against God's command.
2. God sends a plague on Israel.
3. On the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite.
4. The descendants of Aaron.

JULY 8

1. They are assigned roles as gatekeepers, treasurers, and other officials.
2. Solomon, his son.
3. He advises Solomon to serve God with wholehearted devotion and a willing mind.
4. He prays for Solomon and for the people of Israel, and thanks God for all His blessings.
